

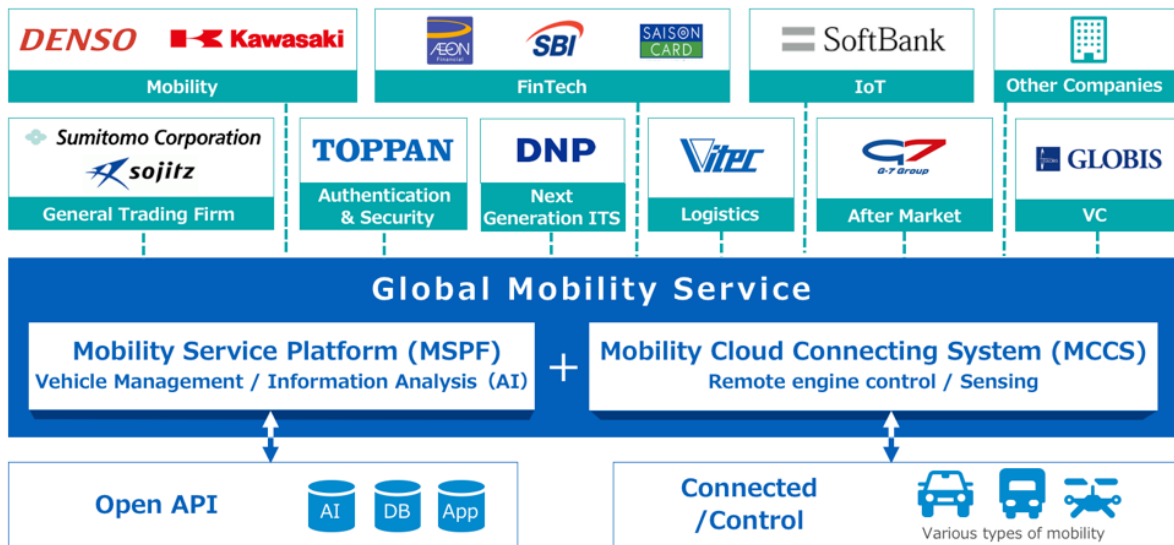

We will continue to recruit a wide range of business alliance partners from various industries to provide services to support more working drivers.
