Helping to provide financial access towards the 1.7 billion poor and low-income population who cannot afford cars, Global Mobility Service Inc. GMS became the first Japanese global venture to be certified as a partner of WIPO GREEN.



WIPO GREEN\* is a global platform established in 2013 by the World Intellectual Property Organization (WIPO). It supports global efforts to address environmental issues by connecting providers and seekers of environmentally friendly technologies. Currently, more than 6,000 individuals and corporations in 170 countries are part of the WIPO GREEN network. Through its FinTech services, GMS is creating opportunities for people who could not use cars because they could not pass the credit screening for conventional loans and leases to use cars, and is working to solve poverty through income improvement and job creation. As part of these efforts, GMS promotes the replacement of old vehicles with new models with low emissions, thereby contributing to the improvement of air quality. Its proprietary patented technology which enables safe remote control of a vehicle engine has been registered in the WIPO GREEN database, and by accelerating open innovation through WIPO GREEN, GMS will further contribute to the realization of a sustainable society.

With our vision "We create a system in which all hard workers are recognized", GMS is a fintech startup working for financial inclusion by creating credit for the 1.7 billion poor and low-income people in the world. By analyzing vehicle data (driving status, speed, etc.) collected by the MCCS, an IoT device equipped with technology to remotely control vehicles, and financial data (payment status, etc.) obtained in conjunction with financial institutions, we visualize the creditworthiness of drivers and create opportunities to utilize financial services such as loans and leases for those who are unable to qualify for conventional credit screening. As of October 2020, we have raised a cumulative total of 5.6 billion yen in recognition of our business model of addressing social issues by creating job opportunities for poor and low-income people in Japan and in ASEAN countries (Philippines, Cambodia, and Indonesia). We will continue to contribute to the international community towards the realization of a prosperous society through a business model that creates economic rationality in solving problems such as poverty.
