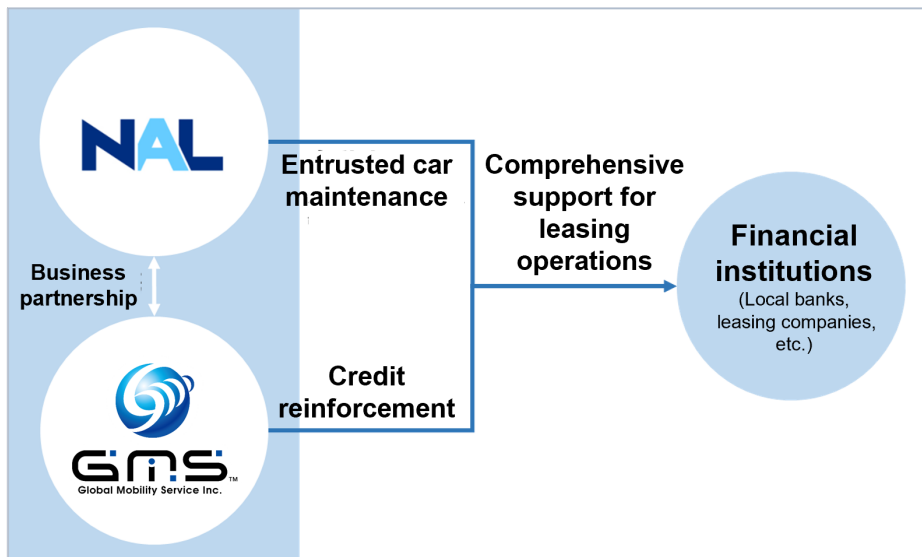


Global Mobility Service and NAL Net Communications form business alliance to provide inclusive car lease services to financial institutions
